Carsten Schwarz, director of Division of Cystic Fibrosis (CF), lung transplantation program for CF, and endoscopy unit of the pediatrics hospital at the Charité in Berlin is a specialist for pneumology. He is president of the managing board of the AGAM (working group of doctors for CF) in Germany since 2011, and in this function he recently published the AWMF S3 guideline "Pseudomonas infection in cystic fibrosis". Presently, he is founding the ECFS Fungal Pathogens Working Group within the European CF Society (ECFS). His scientific core areas mainly cover infectiology in CF. Present topics – supported by international and national scientific grants – comprise the significance of colonization and infection with fungi in CF. He has published numerous highly respected articles in this field.
