Prof. Dr. Roland Lill is Professor of Cell Biology at Philipps-Universität Marburg, Germany and Director of the Institut für Zytobiologie. He is a member of the German Academy of Sciences Leopoldina and of EMBO. In 2003 he received the Leibniz Prize of DFG for his discovery of iron-sulfur protein biogenesis in eukaryotes. The lecture will summarize what we currently know about the molecular mechanism of this essential process of life and its many associated 'FeS diseases'.
