



## 1. University-specific Building Blocks

### Building Block 1b: Gender Medicine Research and Teaching at the Medical University of Innsbruck

Sex-/gender and diversity sensitive medicine has been taught at the Medical University of Innsbruck since 2006; in the years thereafter, it was successively expanded. Since 2015 the discipline has been a compulsory part of the following degree programs: Human- and dental medicine, PhD program for clinical medical science, Bachelor's and Master's Degree programs in molecular medicine. Taught are the fundamentals, sex-/gender and diversity sensitive medicine as a cross-cutting topic as well as methodology for the purpose of considering sex and gender-specific aspects in research and teaching. Particularly noteworthy is the public lecture series Diversity in Medicine, which has been running since 2007 and covers a wide range of medical and medicine-related subjects. Furthermore, students, young scientists, and teachers are given guidelines in compact form to teach them methodology for *scientific work*, *applications for grants* and *sex/gender & teaching*.
